

CETAQUA PRIVACY POLICY

INFORMATION REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA VIDEO SURVEILLANCE AND ACCESS CONTROL

Below you will find information regarding the processing of your personal data collected through video surveillance systems and access control systems at our facilities.

Data Controller:

Depending on the facility where the data processing takes place, the Data Controller will be one of the following entities, as specified on the corresponding video surveillance information notice:

- **CETAQUA, CENTRO TECNOLÓGICO DEL AGUA, FUNDACIÓN PRIVADA**, with Tax ID (NIF) G64386626 and registered office at C/ D'Esplugues 75, Cornellà de Llobregat (Barcelona).
- **CENTRO ANDALUZ DE INVESTIGACIONES DEL AGUA, FUNDACIÓN PRIVADA**, with Tax ID (NIF) G93217743 and registered office at C/ Periodista Federico Alba, 7, 29620 Torremolinos, Málaga.
- **CENTRO GALLEGO DE INVESTIGACIONES DEL AGUA, FUNDACIÓN PRIVADA**, with Tax ID (NIF) G70312020 and registered office at Rua Campus Vida S/N, Santiago de Compostela.

Each of these entities acts as an **independent Data Controller** in relation to processing activities carried out at their respective facilities.

Categories of personal data collected:

- **Image data:** captured by security cameras. All cameras are duly signposted.
- **Identification and contact data:** collected through visitor access control systems at offices and facilities.
- **Data generated through the use of access devices or card readers:** entry and exit records.

Purpose:

To ensure the security of individuals, property, and facilities, and to integrate emergency and evacuation procedures in situations of risk within the facilities.

Legal basis for processing:

Legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)) and Article 22 of Spanish Organic Law 3/2018 on the Protection of Personal Data and Guarantee of Digital Rights.

Who has access to your data:

- Authorised company personnel.
- Service providers: security service providers and equipment maintenance companies in the performance of their duties. The corresponding Data Processing Agreements have been executed.
- Law enforcement authorities, Courts and Tribunals in the event of a security incident or indication of a criminal offence.

Retention period:

The data will be deleted within a maximum period of one month from the date of capture, unless it must be retained to provide evidence of acts affecting the integrity of persons, property, or facilities. In such cases, the data will be made available to the competent authority within 72 hours from the time the existence of the incident becomes known.

Your rights:

Right	Description
Right of access	To obtain confirmation as to whether we process your personal data and to access such data.
Right to rectification	To request correction of inaccurate or incomplete personal data.
Right to object	To request that we do not process personal data for certain specific purposes.
Right to erasure	To request deletion of personal data.
Right to restriction of processing	To request restriction of the processing of personal data.
Right to data portability	To request that we provide this information in an electronic format.
Right to lodge a complaint with the competent authority	As a data subject, you may lodge a complaint with the Spanish Data Protection Agency (Agencia Española de Protección de Datos – www.aepd.es).

You may exercise these rights by contacting the Data Protection Officer. Please note that, although you may exercise any of the above rights, the specific characteristics of this processing activity may not allow us to comply positively with your request in all cases.

You may be required to identify yourself by providing a recent image in order to enable us to locate you in the relevant recording.
